IT HAS BEEN JUST 2 WEEKS SINCE ELLA'S RESCUE FROM CRUELTY AND DESPAIR. DAILY SHE GROWS STRONGER FROM LIFE-THREATENING INFECTION, BROUGHT ON BY PROFOUND 'GREEDER' NEGLIGENCE.



ELLA IS HAPPY NOW, ONCE AGAIN ENJOYING HER PUPPY LUST FOR LIFE. AMPUTATION OF HER FORELIMB IS NECESSARY FOR ELLA TO REMAIN PAIN FREE AND TO ENJOY GOOD MOBILITY, OVER HER LIFETIME. HARTBEATS IN THE HIGHLANDS

HART CONTINUES TO PROVIDE VOLUNTEER ANIMAL RESCUE SERVICE TO 13 MUNICIPALITIES IN THIS REGION, WITH 2 BASIC PROGRAMS:

1. **ADOPTION PROGRAM**, for the rescue of injured, abused and abandoned dogs.
2. **SNIP**, for the low-cost spay/neuter of cats and dogs.

With the advantage of 'outside' donor support, HART is working with the municipal pound, to provide vet care including spay/neuter/vaccines/emergency treatment/responsible placement, for all dogs at the pound.

To date, cats/kittens there have also benefitted...but further work to serve felines is compromised by the sheer number of desperate animals and NO financial nor foster/adoptive resources. Neither HART nor the pound, currently intakes cats.

Spay/Neuter, Trap/Neuter Release Programs, or your own compassion, remain the only answer for suffering cats and kittens.

- DO NOT take stray animals to private volunteer homes. There is a process for 'animal intake,' to prevent viral and parasitic infections to resident animals.
- HART is NOT a pound. Nor do our volunteers catch or steal animals.
- HART workers are all volunteers, who work exhausting hours serving this community. Please consider this when requesting assistance.
- Please call HART or your municipality, for information regarding stray animals.
